## Language Accessibility Advisory Committee Meeting Summary 02/13/2019

## Introduction:

- Hang welcomed everyone and called the LAAC meeting to order
- Introductions around the table

## **Meeting Notes:**

- Elena discussed her thesis on the VCA:
  - Older people vote and younger people do not; Voters who use the touch screen were motivated to come out due to political reasons; More women took her survey over men; The county was thanked for their work; Some voters loved the Voters Choice Act while others liked the Polling Place model; Research was conducted geographically equal; Hardly any turnout until the day before Election Day; Her survey was available in 7 other languages (3 were used – Spanish, Russian and Vietnamese)
- The next Primary Election our office conducts will be moved from June to March
- Senate District 1 Special Election March 26th, 2019
  - o 11 Day vote center opens March 16th; 2 other vote centers open March 23rd
  - Around 90,000 registered voters; Senate District 1 covers areas of Fair Oaks, Folsom, Gold River and Orangevale
- Statistics from the November 2018 Election:
  - o 68% voter turnout with 94% of those voters voting the ballot we mailed them
  - o 5% of voters went to vote in person at a vote center
  - 200,000 vote by mail envelopes were returned election night; 11,000 voters voted a CVR (500 from Sacramento State University vote center)
  - 38% returned their ballots at a drop box location; 34% returned their ballots by mail; 28% returned their ballots at a vote center location
- Return postage during elections is now paid
- Goals for LAAC committee:
  - Create partnerships with organizations in different languages
  - Try and reach ethnic media channels; finding small outlets and having community partners who can help build trust
  - Recommend large events within the community to our office
  - o Help make messaging very clear and concise
  - Dial in on translated content
- Meetings will be bimonthly until August and on Wednesday nights
