

# NOTICE OF ELECTION

Notice is hereby given that Sacramento County Employees' Retirement System will conduct a Member Election during the period of September 20 through October 1, 2021 for the purpose of electing to the Board of Retirement:

## ONE MISCELLANEOUS REPRESENTATIVE

The term of office begins January 1, 2022 and ends December 31, 2024.

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**ELIGIBILITY:** To be eligible to be a candidate or to vote in the election, you must be an active miscellaneous member of the Sacramento County Employees' Retirement System according to System records. Only miscellaneous members may be candidates and/or vote for a Miscellaneous Retirement Board Representative.

## CALENDAR OF EVENTS

July 26, 2021, 8 a.m.	First day to obtain candidate nomination papers
August 6, 2021, 5 p.m.	Last day to file candidate nomination papers along with a candidate statement not exceeding 200 words. May be picked up at Voter Registration and Elections or downloaded from <a href="http://www.elections.saccounty.gov">www.elections.saccounty.gov</a> .
September 20 to October 1, 2021	Voting period (by mail ballot); if using hand delivery or inter-office mail, it must be delivered to the Elections Office by 5:00 p.m. on October 1, 2021; if returning by US mail service it must be postmarked by October 1, 2021 and received by Elections Office by 5:00 p.m. October 4, 2021.
October 1, 2021, 5 p.m.	Last day to cast ballot/End of Voting Period;
October 8, 2021	Official results released
January 1, 2022	Term of office begins

**CANDIDACY INFORMATION:** Nomination papers and candidate statement forms may be obtained and filed at Voter Registration and Elections, 7000 65<sup>th</sup> Street, Suite A, Sacramento, CA 95823, Monday through Friday, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Alternatively, they may be downloaded from [www.elections.saccounty.gov](http://www.elections.saccounty.gov) and returned via email at [voters-campaignservices@saccounty.net](mailto:voters-campaignservices@saccounty.net). If a representative is delegated to file in person on behalf of the candidate, a specific letter of authorization signed by the candidate will be required.

Each candidate is allowed one 200-word statement of qualifications, which will be included in each member's voting material. This statement of qualifications is not verified or corrected by Voter Registration and Elections staff. It will be printed exactly as presented.
