**4 Vote Center Commitment**  
*October 31 – November 3*

### Vote Center Requirements:

- Designated area or room for voting, ideally at least 30 ft. x 30 ft., and free of other activities
- Open to voters a minimum of 8 hours per day, Election Day open 7:00 am - 8:00 pm, with facility accessible to staff 1 hour before and after voting hours
- Restrooms available for Vote Center staff
- Free parking available for voters and Vote Center staff
- Air Conditioning/Heating available each day in the voting area
- Sufficient inside/outside lighting and functioning electrical outlets in designated voting area
- Acceptance and secured storage of voting equipment
- Accessibility survey conducted by Sacramento County Election Officials

## VOTE BY MAIL DROP BOX – Available starting days before Election Day

*February 3 – March 3*

**30 Day Ballot Drop Box Commitment**  
*October 5 – November 3*

### Drop Box Requirements:

- Secured location visible by facility staff
- Available to the public during your regular business hours even on Election Day
- Accessibility survey conducted by County Elections Officials
