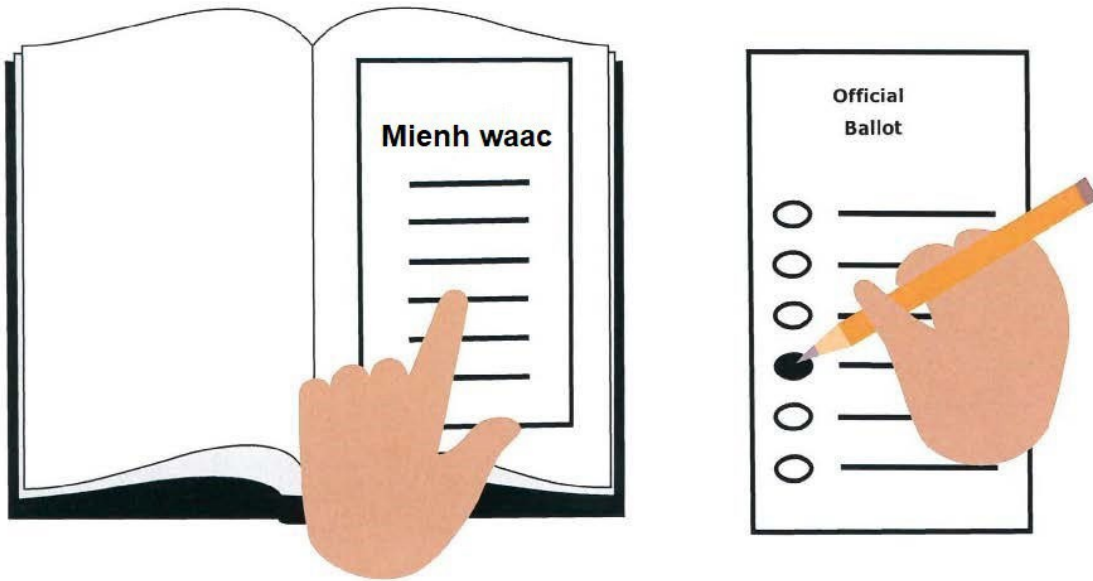

If you make a mistake, ask an election officer or call the Registrar of Voters' Office at (916) 875-6451 for a replacement ballot. A mistake in one contest does not affect the rest of the ballot.
