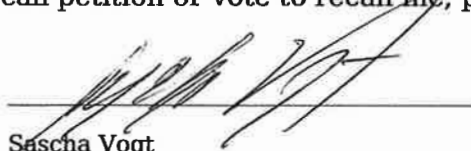

Board actions referenced in the Notice followed stakeholder input, public deliberation and votes taken in public. I considered input and voted consistently with my oath of office.

I was elected to serve the entire community, and I remain available, accountable and committed to that service.
